

COMMONLY ASKED QUESTIONS ABOUT: TUTORING SERVICES

Q. Are we required to provide tutoring?

A. Title 5 does not require a college to provide tutoring. However as mentioned before, students with disabilities must have access to the general college services and instructional process. So if the college chooses to provide tutoring to the general student population it must include students with disabilities in those services, and the college must provide appropriate and necessary accommodations during tutoring. If the college decides to provide DSP&S-funded tutoring, then that tutoring must be specialized in some way that addresses the DSP&S student's disability-related educational/learning issues.
